## The Fight Isn't Over

Much of what the labor movement has fought for has still not been achieved: a livable minimum wage for all workers, guaranteed sick time and paid family leave for major events and emergencies, medical benefits for all that don't disappear when you lose your job, guaranteed paid vacation, a 40 day workweek and equal pay for equal work.

In addition to the constant pressure to roll back existing gains; changing business conditions like the gig economy, robot assembly lines, and outsourcing jobs to the cheapest location, all present special problems.

## Guaranteed Workers Rights in the U.S (in most cases)

Workers not otherwise exempt are entitled to at least the federal minimum wage and overtime pay of one-and-one-half-times the regular rate of pay. Hours for children under 16 are restricted. Jobs deemed too dangerous are forbidden for children under 18.

Workers are entitled to work and a workplace free from recognized, serious hazards. Safety and health conditions in most private industries are regulated by OSHA or OSHA-approved state programs. OSHA also does workplace inspections.

Most labor and public safety laws and many environmental laws mandate whistleblower protections for employees who complain about violations of the law by their employers. Remedies can include job reinstatement and payment of back wages.

Certain persons who serve in the armed forces have a right to reemployment with the employer they were with when they entered service. This includes those called up from the reserves or National Guard.

Employers may use polygraph tests only in very limited circumstances and only with the employee's consent.

Employers of 50 or more employees must give up to 12 weeks of unpaid, job-protected leave to eligible employees for the birth or adoption of a child or for the serious illness of the employee or a spouse, child or parent.

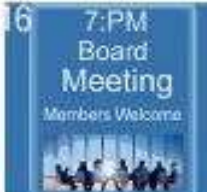
